Language, Literacy and Communication

- ☆ Persuasive posters – salad bar and potions

Mathematical Development:

Datblygiad Mathemategol

- ☆ Learn about capacity using a variety of different plastic bottles to find out which one will hold the most water.
- ☆ Measure water into 100ml containers and compare how the water looks in each container.
- ☆ Sorting safe and dangerous liquids using a VENN diagram
- ☆ Place value – the value of each digit in a number
- ☆ Adding and subtraction strategies – number bonds to 10 and 20, doubling to 20 and adding 9 / 11 quickly.
- ☆ Counting in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s – link to multiplication tables
