- ☆ Film and Digital media – monologue of an evacuee reflecting and remembering.



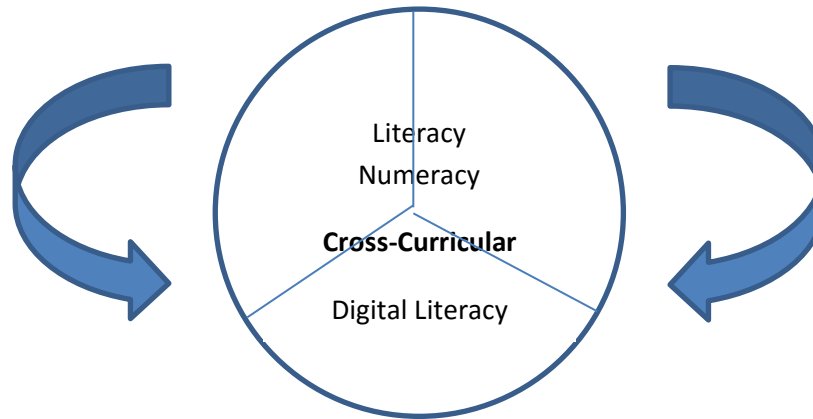
Humanities
