

Below are some **suggested** daily tasks to be completed at home. We encourage parents to spend approximately 30 minutes to an hour per day with their child/ren on these activities.



Day	Activity
Monday	<p>Language- With your grown up listen to the story of 'Supertato'. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=rze89HB9u8g</p> <p>Would you like to be a superhero? What would your superhero suit look like? What would your powers be?</p> <p>With a grown up you could colour in your own superhero suit and mask.</p>
Tuesday	<p>Maths- Your superhero needs a city to look after. Can you build a city out of blocks? Can you make a big and small buildings? How many blocks have you used?</p> <p>If you haven't got any blocks to build with are there any other objects around your house you could use (books, cereal boxes etc)?</p>

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Day	Activity
Monday	<p>Language: Listen to the story "How do you feel" by Anthony Browne https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kILR7wfi-X4</p> <p>Talk about how you feel today and why? Ask your family members how they feel today.</p>
Tuesday	<p>Maths: Number Matching. Take a look at the examples below - can you match the dots to the correct numbers? You could use paper cups or empty containers such as yoghurt pots. You could also practice recognising numbers by matching up numbers on cars to their car parking spaces.</p>
Wednesday	<p>Language: Welsh - feelings. Use the Welsh vocabulary posters to talk about your feelings in Welsh.</p> <p>Draw of picture of yourself showing how you feel. Look at the pictures of the mood monster- what colour could you use to show your mood?</p>






